

Student Safety and Protection Policy
Wheaton Academy
Revised April 2015

We want to ensure the safety and well-being of our students as they travel with Wheaton Academy. As a result, Wheaton Academy reserves the right to evaluate whether a student is fit to travel. If any of the following situations apply to a student, he or she may not be permitted to travel during Winterim:

- Student has been asked to re-apply to Wheaton Academy.
- Student is currently on probation.
- Student has been hospitalized due to behavioral or emotional diagnosis within the past year.
- Student has engaged in self-harming behavior or expressed suicidal ideation within the past year.
- Student has been involved in a level two infraction (as stated in the Student Handbook) within the past year.
- Student has a physical or medical condition that may pose as a threat in light of the trip destination and/or itinerary.
- Student has been identified as having other issues of concern to Wheaton Academy personnel.

A student will likely be removed from a trip if any of the above situations occur after the trip application period but before trip departure. In some circumstances, the school may also ask families to purchase a “cancel for any reason” trip insurance policy for trip application approval.
