



## Assistant Basketball Coach

**Department:** Athletic

**Reports To:** Head Varsity Basketball Coach

**Classification:** Temporary/Seasonal

**Benefits:** This position is not eligible for benefits

**Job Summary:** The Assistant Basketball Coach supports the Head Varsity Basketball Coach by maintaining the Basketball program's overall level of excellence, its reputation within the community, the leadership of the coaching staff, and the physical and spiritual development of players.

### Essential duties include the following. Other duties may be assigned:

1. Coaches varsity or junior varsity players, as assigned by varsity coach.
2. Attends all regular season and post-season practices and games.
3. Continues to pursue growth in skills as a position coach by learning from other coaching staff and attending coaching clinics.
4. Uses requisite technology independently to perform coaching instructional and program operational duties.
5. Assistant coaches are assigned select roles by the head varsity coach. These could include:
  - a. Coaching:
    - i. Position strategy and coordination.
    - ii. Player discipleship and leadership development.
    - iii. Development and oversight of other assistant coaches.
  - b. Communication:
    - i. Assist with communication to parents
    - ii. Assist with communication to players
    - iii. Assist with communication to parent volunteers
    - iv. Assist with social media:
      1. Coordination with Sports Information Director to keep social media and website current.
  - c. Program operations
    - i. Athletic Trainer coordination.
    - ii. Assist with referee coordination.
    - iii. Assist with team excursions.
    - iv. Assist with community and school service activities.
    - v. Assist with college recruiting.
    - vi. Assist with summer camp operations.
    - vii. Representing Wheaton Academy within in the conference and IHSA.

**Qualifications:** The Assistant Basketball Coach must be a spiritually sensitive individual who understands the mission of Wheaton Academy and is committed to help see it become a reality in the lives of our students by manifesting, by precept and example, the highest Christian virtue and personal decorum, serving as a Christian role model (I Timothy 4:12) both in and out of school (Luke 6:40), and as an example to parents and fellow employees in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living. This individual must maintain active participation in a protestant evangelical church.



The ideal candidate has prior collegiate playing experience. This person is knowledgeable of the game and has prior coaching experience. This individual has proven leadership experience in directing others and a program toward the completion of a vision in coaching or other professional contexts.
